

## **FEDERICO MOSQUERA (A Coruña, 1986)**



Spanish-born Federico Mosquera Martínez is active both as a pianist and composer. His works have been performed in Spain, Portugal, France, the UK, Italy, Estonia, the Netherlands, Cuba and China, highlighting his premieres with the Real Filharmonía de Galicia (*Concertino for string orchestra* (2011) conducted by Maximino Zumalave) and the Orquesta Sinfónica de Galicia (*Three Symphonic Movements* (2012) under the baton of Víctor Pablo Pérez; *Rituales y Sortilegios* (2015, commissioned by the SGAE Foundation) conducted by Dima Slobodeniouk; and his *Tuba Concerto* (2017) conducted by José Trigueros with Jesper Boile Nielsen as soloist). Furthermore, his *Concerto for bass clarinet* (2013) was performed by the renowned bass clarinetist Henri Bok in China and Portugal in its arrangement for wind orchestra.

He has performed at major venues such as Jurriaanse zaal and Grote zaal of de Doelen (Rotterdam, The Netherlands), Zeeuwse Concertzaal (Middelburg, The Netherlands), Casa da Música (Porto, Portugal), and festivals such as Harnos festival 2010, Festival Repeat 2011, The Hague Chamber Music Festival (2013), Gergiev Festival 2013, Piano duo Festival (2014) in Amsterdam, both as a soloist and chamber musician.

He obtained degrees with distinction, studying under the direction of pianists such as Andrzej Pikul (Akademia Muzyczna Kraków) and Jean-Bernard Pommier (Codarts, University for the Arts), and composers such as Antón García Abril and Hans Koolmees, in the conservatories of La Coruña, Kraków (Poland) and Rotterdam (The Netherlands), where he currently holds a position as Artistic Research Coach.
